The Illinois University Council for Career and Technical Education, as part of its goals and objectives, is offering CTE faculty members of the Council the opportunity to work with business and industry professionals in CTE specific areas. The goal of this practicum is to work with business/industry and education professionals for a maximum of five days (consecutive or non-consecutive) to better understand the implications for CTE classroom teachers and their preparation. Each Council member who is accepted through this application process would be paid \$200 per day. A final report would be due no later than June 15, 2011 to Dr. Chris Merrill.

The application process should include a word-processed document that contains, at minimum:

- Your name
- University mailing address
- E-mail address
- CTE practicum area
- Business/industry name
- Goals of practicum
- Statement of teaching and learning
- Number of days for practicum

The final report must include how the goals of the practicum were met and how this practicum will change the teaching and learning in your CTE program.
